General Comment

Comments from Korean governments(Ministry of Science and ICT)

2. The Korean government is partially supporting the R&D budget for Open-RAN and is considering various measures to boost private cooperation.

23. In order to promote teaming, it is necessary to expand the funding target not only to US companies but also to non-US companies that want to cooperate in Open-RAN.

25.a. Enabling countries other than the United States to benefit will help the global spread of Open-RAN.

25.b. Even for companies that are not headquartered in the United States, supporting companies willing to cooperate on Open-RAN will help the global spread of Open-RAN.

25.c. It is also necessary to review relaxed regulations on products produced by companies in countries that have global partnerships with the United States on Open-RAN for the spread of Open-RAN.

26. It is necessary to specify a cooperation plan with the government.
